



Kiyoshi Kobayashi is Professor of Infrastructure Economics, Graduate School of Management and the Director of the Research Center of Business Administration, Kyoto University. He is also Professor of Planning and Management Theory of Graduate School of Engineering, Kyoto University. He was Dean of Graduate School of Management for the period of 2010-2012. He is a world renowned researcher in the fields of Urban and Infrastructure Management and Economics and a recipient of several awards including the Distinguished Research Awards by Japan Society of Civil Engineers, Fellow Awards by RSA International, and Education Awards by the Danish Ministry of Environment as well as by the Vietnamese Minister of Education. He was experienced the Vice President of Japan Society of Civil Engineers, the President of the Applied Regional Science Conference, Global Business Society and serves on the editorial boards of international journals including the American Society of Civil Engineers, Annals of Regional Science, the series editor-in-chief of the Journals of Japan Society of Civil Engineers and the Journal of Applied Regional Science. Currently, he is a member of National Land Development Council of Japan, a committee expert on Transport Policy Council of Japan, and a coalition member of Science Council of Japan. He was an adjunct professor of 10 overseas universities and a visiting fellow of international organizations of I IIASA, OECD, WHO, and World Bank, etc. He is the author and co-editor of 65 books and over 430 academic reviewed papers.
